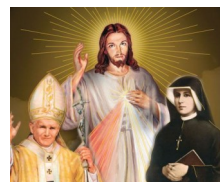
Wednesday, April 24— all parishioners are welcome!!!

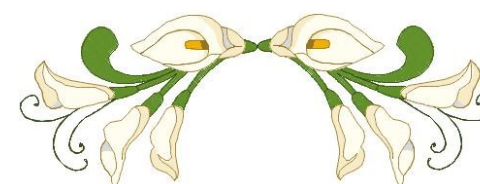
