INVITATION to listen - Our parish is hosting the Northwest Deanery Synod Meeting on Tuesday, January 25 from 5:00-8:00pm. 5:00pm Opening prayer in the church, 5:30pm sandwich supper, 6:00-7:45pm listening to parish representatives share their recommendations to Bishop Nickless. Bishop will listen but not take questions. What's a synod? Holy Father, Pope Francis, has announced a Synod to lead the whole Church into a deeper understanding of our mission in the world. Bishops, priests and deacons will organize and attend meetings in every diocese around the world with the purpose of listening to the concerns, the joys, the frustrations, the ideas and even the anger of the faithful related to the Catholic Church today and where they suggest it should move toward tomorrow.
